Core


Meta

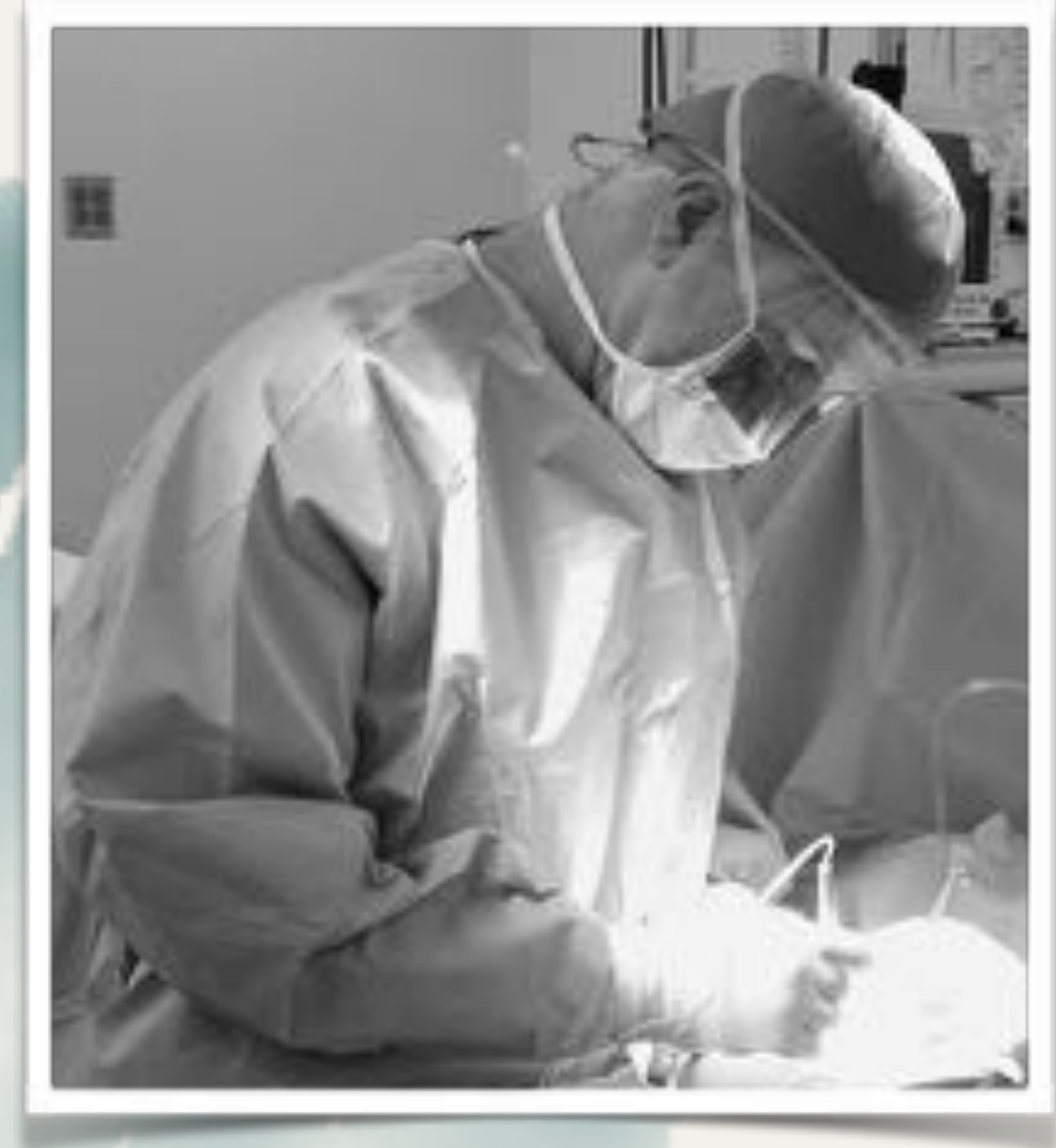
